

Directive N° 004-2007-IN/0105- Procedures for the input, registry, consultation and report of information into the RETA System.

On February 23, 2007 the Ministry of the Interior issued Ministerial Resolution N° 129-2007-IN/0105, through which the Ministry approved Directive N° 004-2007-IN/0105 - Procedures for the input, registry, consultation and report of information into the RETA System.

This Directive replaced the Police Directive, in accordance with the newly approved *Law 28950- Law against Human Trafficking and the Illicit Transfer of Migrants* and extended its jurisdiction to all personnel within both civil and police units of the Ministry of the Interior. At the same time, it established that access to the RETA System will occur via the internet- at [www.retapnp.com](http://www.retapnp.com)- and that the Permanent Secretary for the National Commission of Human Rights has sole responsibility for the monitoring of the progressive implementation and use by dependent police units both within the investigative police system as well as within family police units.
